Domaine Des Dieux's Ostrich Tagliata

with crispy lemony lentils & baby tomatoes

The combination of the juicy steak, baby tomatoes, green leaves, lemony lentils, piquanté peppers, and sharp Italian cheese, all brought together with a light, tangy dressing, makes for a flavourful and satisfying salad.

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Ingredients & Prep

120g	Tinned Lentils <i>drain & rinse</i>
15ml	Lemon Juice
150g	Free-range Ostrich Fillet
5ml	NOMU One For All Rub
20ml	Balsamic Vinegar
80g	Baby Tomatoes <i>rinse & cut in half</i>
20g	Green Leaves <i>rinse</i>
20g	Piquanté Peppers <i>drain</i>
20g	Italian-style Hard Cheese <i>roughly chop</i>
10g	Sunflower Seeds

From Your Kitchen

Oil (cooking, olive or coconut)
Salt & Pepper
Water
Sugar/Sweetener/Honey
Paper Towel
Butter

1. CRISPY LENTILS Place a pan (with a lid) over medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, toast the drained lentils until golden and crispy, 8-10 minutes (shifting occasionally). If they start to pop out, use a lid to rein them in. Deglaze the pan with the lemon juice. Remove from the pan and season.

2. OSTRICH Place a pan over medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. Pat the ostrich dry with paper towel. When hot, sear the ostrich until browned, 2-3 minutes per side (for medium-rare). In the final 1-2 minutes, baste with a knob of butter and the NOMU rub. Remove from the pan and set aside to rest for 5 minutes before slicing and seasoning.

3. JUST BEFORE SERVING In a bowl, combine the balsamic vinegar with 30ml of olive oil, a sweetener (to taste), and season. Add the halved tomatoes, the rinsed green leaves, the lemony lentils, and the drained piquanté peppers.

4. DINNER IS READY Dish up the salad, top with the ostrich slices, and sprinkle over the chopped cheese. Garnish with a sprinkle of the sunflower seeds. Well done, Chef!



Chef's Tip

Place the sunflower seeds in a pan over medium heat. Toast until golden brown, 2-3 minutes (shifting occasionally). Remove from the pan and set aside.
