75ml	150ml	White Basmati Rice rinse	
160g	320g	Free-range Ostrich Steak	
5ml	10ml	NOMU Moroccan Rub	
50g	100g	Cucumber rinse & dice	
1	1	Tomato rinse & roughly dice	
40ml	80ml	Creamy Pesto	

Yoghurt & 10ml [20ml] Pesto Princess Basil Pestol

Oil (cooking, olive or coconut)

Water
Paper Towel

Butter Seasoning (salt & pepper) 1. RICE Place the rice in a pot with 100ml [200ml] of salted water. Cover with a lid and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat and simmer until the water has been absorbed, 8-10 minutes. Remove from the heat and set aside to steam, 8-10 minutes. Fluff with a fork and cover.

2. NOW FOR THE PROTEIN Place a pan over medium-high with a drizzle of oil. Pat the ostrich dry with paper towel. When hot, sear the ostrich until browned, 2-3 minutes per side (for medium-rare). In the final 1-2 minutes, baste with a knob of butter and the NOMU rub. Remove from the pan and set aside to rest for 5 minutes before slicing and seasoning.

3. LOADED RICE In a bowl, combine the rice, the cucumber, the tomato, and seasoning.

4. O-YUM OSTRICH Make a bed of the loaded rice and top with the ostrich slices. Dollop over the creamy pesto. Easy peasy, Chef!
