Ingredients & Prep Actions:

120g	120g	Carrot
200g	400g	Potato
1	1	Onion
150g	300g	Beef Mince
15ml	30ml	Curry Spice <i>(1 [2] Bay Leaf/ves, 2.5ml [5ml] Dried Chilli Flakes, 5ml [10ml] Medium Curry Powder & 7.5ml [15ml] NOMU Garam Masala Rub)</i>
50g	100g	Cooked Chopped Tomato
2	4	Rotis

From Your Kitchen

Oil (cooking, olive or coconut)

Seasoning (salt & pepper)

Water

Sugar/Sweetener/Honey

1. PREP STEP Rinse, trim, peel, and cut the carrots into bite-sized pieces. Rinse, peel (optional), and cut the potatoes into bite-sized pieces. Peel and roughly dice ½ [\[all\]](#) of the onion.

2. START THE CURRY Place a pot over medium heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, fry the carrot and the potatoes until lightly golden, 5-6 minutes.

3. SPICY AROMAS Add the mince and the onions to the pot. Fry until the onions are soft and the mince is slightly golden, 4-5 minutes. Add the curry spice and fry until fragrant, 1-2 minutes. Mix in the cooked chopped tomato, 100ml [\[200ml\]](#) of water, and bring to a boil. Simmer until reduced, and the veggies are cooked through, 8-10 minutes. Remove from the heat, add a sweetener (to taste) and season.

4. TOASTED ROTIS Place a clean pan over medium heat. When hot, toast each roti until warmed through, 30-60 seconds per side. Alternatively, spread them out on a plate in a single layer and heat up in the microwave, 30-60 seconds.

5. DINNER IS READY Make a bed of the curry and side with the toasted rotis. (Alternatively: load the toasted rotis with the curry, wrap them up, and enjoy). Well done, Chef!
