Ingredients & Prep Actions:

240g	480g	Carrot rinse, trim, peel & cut into bite-sized pieces on the diagonal
1	1	Onion peel & cut ½ [1] into wedges
5ml	10ml	Dried Oregano
1	1	Bell Pepper rinse, deseed & cut ½ [1] into thick strips
75g	150g	Shredded Cabbage & Carrots
1	1	Spring Onion rinse, trim & finely slice, keeping the white & green parts separate
60ml	120ml	Dijon Yoghurt (55ml [110ml] Greek Yoghurt & 5ml [10ml] Dijon Mustard)
150g	300g	Pork Fillet
5ml	10ml	NOMU Spanish Rub
From Yo	ur Kitchen

Paper Towel Cooking Spray

- 1. ROAST Preheat the oven to 200°C. Spread the carrot and the onion on a roasting tray. Lightly spray with cooking spray until evenly coated, add oregano, and season. Roast in the hot oven until golden, 25-30 minutes (shifting halfway). Alternatively, air fry at 200°C until crispy, 20-25 minutes (shifting halfway). 2. GREEN PEPPER Lightly spray the pepper with cooking spray and season. When the roast has 10-12 minutes remaining, scatter over the pepper and roast for the remaining time until lightly charred.
- 3. CREAMY SLAW In a bowl, combine the slaw with spring onion whites, dijon yoghurt, seasoning, and set aside in the fridge.
- 4. PORK Place a pan over medium heat. Pat the pork dry with paper towel, coat with the NOMU rub, cooking spray, and seasoning. When hot, sear the pork until browned, 2-3 minutes (shifting occasionally). Remove from the pan, wrap in tinfoil, pop in the oven and roast until cooked through, 4-6 minutes. Remove from the oven and rest for 5 minutes before slicing.
- 5. DINNER IS READY Dish up the roast, side with the pork slices, and the creamy slaw. Garnish with the spring onion greens and enjoy, Chef!

Chef's Tip Slice the pork across the grain and with a sharp knife so you don't mash the fibres
