- 1. RICE & PEAS Place the rice in a pot with 200ml [400ml] of salted water. Cover with a lid and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat and simmer until the water has been absorbed, about 10 minutes. Remove from the heat, add the peas, and set aside to steam, 8-10 minutes. Fluff with a fork and cover.

 2. OSTRICH & SOY SAUCE SLURRY Place a pan over medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. Pat
- the ostrich dry with paper towel. When hot, sear the ostrich until browned, 2-3 minutes (shifting occasionally). Remove from the pan and cut into bite-sized pieces. Set aside. In a bowl, combine the soy sauce mix, and the corn flour to make a slurry.

 3. GINGER CARROTS Return the pan to medium heat. When hot, fry the carrots pieces, and the onion
- 3. GINGER CARROIS Return the pan to medium heat. When hot, try the carrots pieces, and the onio until starting to brown and soften, 5-8 minutes. Add the ginger until fragrant, 1-2 minutes.
 - 4. SIMMER YOUR DINNER Add the soy sauce slurry, 50ml [100ml] of water, and a sweetener (to taste). Simmer until slightly thickened 3-4 minutes. Add the browned meat, and seasoning.
 - 5. DELISH DISH Dish up the fluffy rice, and spoon over the saucy ostrich. Enjoy!
