1. BALSAMIC T&O In a bowl, combine the balsamic vinegar, the oregano and the tomato and set aside to pickle. Drain right before serving.

2. CRISPY CHICKPEAS Place a pan over medium heat. When hot, toast the chickpeas until golden and

- crispy, 12-15 minutes (shifting occasionally). In the final 1-2 minutes, add the Everything bagel spice. If the chickpeas start to pop out, use a lid to rein them in. Remove from the pan and set aside.

 3. NOMU-SPICED OSTRICH Return the pan to medium-high heat with a small amount of cooking spray. Pat the ostrich dry with paper towel. Sear the ostrich until browned, 2-3 minutes per side (for
