120g	Baby Carrots rinsed & halved lengthways, keeping the stems intact
100g	Broccoli Florets cut into bite-sized chund
1	Red Onion 1/4 peeled & finely diced
4g	Fresh Parsley rinsed & finely chopped
10g	Walnuts roughly chopped
10ml	Sumac Spice
1	Basa Fillet
1	Garlic Clove peeled & grated
1	Lemon ½ cut into wedges
15ml	Tahini
20g	Salad Leaves rinsed

1. ROASTED VEGGIES Preheat the oven to 200°C. Place the halved baby carrots and broccoli chunks on a roasting tray. Coat in oil and seasoning. Roast in the hot oven for 20-25 minutes until softened and	
starting to caramelise, shifting halfway. 2. SUMAC SALSA In a bowl, combine the diced onion, the chopped parsley, the chopped walnuts, the sumac spice, a drizzle of oil and seasoning. Set aside for serving.	
3. SIZZLING BASA When the roast veg has 10 minutes remaining, pat the basa dry with paper towel. Place a nonstick pan over a medium-high	

heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, fry the fish for 2-3 minutes per side until cooked through and golden. Remove from the pan on completion.

4. TAHINI SAUCE Return the pan, wiped down if necessary, to a

SHOW THEM WHOSE BASA! Plate up the flaky basa and top with the creamy tahini sauce and the fragrant sumac salsa. Side with the rinsed salad leaves and the roasted veggies. Serve with any remaining lemon
