Peanut Chicken & Rice

with toasted peanuts & fresh coriander

If you've never tried Moroccan flavours, you're in for a mouthwatering treat, Chef! Soon you will be plating up fluffy basmati rice next to an aromatic marriage of flavours: browned chicken mince coated in a sauce of NOMU Moroccan rub, tangy tomato paste & rich peanut butter. Finished with toasted peanuts and herby coriander.

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Ingredients & Prep

400ml	White Basmati Rice <i>rinsed</i>
40g	Peanuts <i>roughly chopped</i>
600g	Free-range Chicken Mince
2	Onions <i>peeled & roughly diced</i>
40ml	NOMU Moroccan Rub
60ml	Tomato Paste
200ml	Peanut Butter
60ml	Lemon Juice
10g	Fresh Coriander <i>rinsed, picked & roughly chopped</i>

From Your Kitchen

Oil (cooking, olive or coconut)
Salt & Pepper
Water
Sugar/Sweetener/Honey

1. FLUFFY RICE Place the rinsed rice in a pot with 600ml of salted water. Cover with a lid and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat and simmer until the water has been absorbed, 8-10 minutes. Remove from the heat and set aside to steam, 8-10 minutes. Fluff with a fork.

2. TOAST Place the chopped peanuts in a pan over medium heat. Toast until golden brown, 2-4 minutes (shifting occasionally). Remove from the pan and set aside.

3. MINCE Return the pan to medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, add the mince and work quickly to break it up as it starts to cook. Fry until browned, 5-6 minutes (shifting occasionally).

4. PEANUT STEW Add the diced onions to the pan with the mince and fry until soft, 4-5 minutes. Add the NOMU rub and the tomato paste. Fry until fragrant, 1-2 minutes. Pour in 800ml of water. Bring to a boil, reduce the heat, and simmer until slightly reduced, 8-10 minutes. In the final 2-3 minutes, stir in the peanut butter and simmer until thickened. Remove from heat, add a sweetener, and season.

5. TIME TO EAT Make a bed of the fluffy rice, top with the peanut chicken, and drizzle over the lemon juice (to taste). Garnish with the toasted nuts and the chopped coriander. Easy, Chef!
