200g	400g	Sweet Potato Chunks rinse & cut into bite-siz pieces	
60g	120g	Chickpeas drain & rinse

Spinach rinse

1. RUSTIC MASH Preheat the oven to 200°C. Spread the sweet potato on a roasting tray. Coat in oil and season. Roast in the hot oven until golden, 25-30 minutes (shifting halfway). Alternatively, place the sweet potato in a pot of salted water. Bring to the boil and cook until soft, 15-20 minutes. Place the sweet potato in a bowl with a knob of butter alternative and a splash of water or milk alternative. Mash with a fork and cover.

2. CRISPY CHICKPEAS Place a pan (with a lid) over medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, toast the chickpeas until golden and crispy, 6-8 minutes (shifting occasionally). If they start to pop out, use a lid to rein them in. Remove from the pan and season. 3. MMMUSHROOMS Return the pan to medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. Fry the mushrooms until

golden, 5-6 minutes (shifting occasionally). Remove from the pan and season. 4. TANGY COCONUT CREAM Return the pan to medium heat with a drizzle of oil. Fry the onion until golden, 4-5 minutes (shifting occasionally). Add the garlic, and the tomato paste, and fry until fragrant, 1-2 minutes. Add the coconut cream, and 100ml [200ml] of water and simmer until slightly reduced, 6-8 minutes.

5. ALMOST THERE Once the curry has thickened, add the chickpeas and allow to warm, 4-5 minutes. Remove from the heat and add the sun-dried tomatoes, the spinach, the mushrooms, and seasoning.

6. DIG INTO DINNER Plate up the rustic mash, and serve with the creamy tomato chickpeas on top. Tuck in!

Chef's Tip Coat the sweet potato in oil and season. Air fry at 200°C until crispy, 20-25 minutes (shifting halfway).
