Ingredients & Prep Actions:

300g	400g	Udon Noodles
450g	600g	Free-range Ostrich Strips
190g	250g	Button Mushrooms <i>wipe clean & roughly slice</i>
150g	200g	Peas
3	4	Spring Onions <i>rinse, trim & finely slice</i>
240ml	320ml	Tangy Peanut-soy <i>(120ml [160ml] Peanut Butter, 90ml [120ml] Low Sodium Soy Sauce & 30ml [40ml] Rice Wine Vinegar)</i>
60g	80g	Spinach <i>rinse</i>
60ml	80ml	Banhoek Chilli Oil
30g	40g	Peanuts

From Your Kitchen

Oil (cooking, olive or coconut)
Seasoning (Salt & Pepper)
Water
Paper Towel

1. **DONE THE UDONE** Bring a pot of water to a boil for the noodles. Cook the noodles until separated and pliable, 1-2 minutes. Drain, reserving a cup of pasta water, and toss through a drizzle of olive oil.

2. **O-YUM OSTRICH** Place a pan over medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. Pat the ostrich dry with paper towel. When hot, fry the ostrich until browned, 1-2 minutes (shifting occasionally). Remove from the pan and season. You may need to do this step in batches.

3. **VEGGIE MEDLEY** Return the pan to medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. Fry the mushrooms until golden, 6-7 minutes (shifting occasionally). In the final 1-2 minutes, add the peas, the spring onions, the peanut-soy sauce, a sweetener (to taste), the cooked ostrich, the cooked noodles and the spinach. Mix until heated through and the spinach is wilted. Loosen with the reserved pasta water if too thick. Season and remove from the heat.

4. **SO SATISFYING** Serve up the delicious ostrich & noodles and drizzle with the chilli oil (to taste). Garnish with the peanuts and dig in, Chef!

Chef's Tip Toast the peanuts in a pan over medium heat until golden brown, 2-4 minutes (shifting occasionally).
