Ingredients & Prep Actions:

Remove from the pan and drain on paper towel, and and cut into bite-sized pieces.

2. CHARRED CORN Return the pan to medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, fry the corn until lightly charred, 3-4 minutes (shifting occasionally). Remove from the pan and set aside.

3. SAUCY MOMENT Return the pan to medium heat with a drizzle of oil if necessary. Fry the onions

until soft and lightly golden, 7-8 minutes. Add the NOMU rub, and fry until fragrant, 1-2 minutes. Mix in the tomato passata and 300ml [400ml] of water. Simmer until thickened, 10-12 minutes. In the final

1. PERFECT PATTIES Remove the patties from the freezer. Place a pan or grill pan over medium-high

heat with a generous drizzle of oil. When hot, fry the patties until browned, 2-3 minutes per side.

- 1-2 minutes, mix in the chipotle (to taste). Remove from the heat, add a sweetener (to taste), mix in the patty pieces, and season.4. HOMEMADE GUAC Halve the avocados and scoop the avocado flesh into a bowl and mash with a
- fork. Add the tomato (to taste), the lemon juice (to taste), the coriander, and season.

 5. TASTY, TOASTY TORTILLAS Place a clean pan over medium heat. When hot, toast each tortilla until warmed through, 30-60 seconds per side.
- 6. TIME TO EAT Top the tortillas with the saucy mixture, the lettuce, the corn, and finish with dollops of the guacamole. Dig in, Chef!
