with a knife in a cross-hatch pattern without piercing all the way down to the skin. Spread the aubergine halves cut-side up on a roasting tray. Coat in oil and season. Roast in the hot oven until softened, 30-35 minutes (shifting halfway). Alternatively, air fry at 200°C until cooked through, 20-25 minutes (shifting halfway). 2. PREP THE EXTRAS In a salad bowl, combine the vinegar, a drizzle of olive oil, 5ml [10ml] of

sweetener, and seasoning. Add the chickpeas, the tomato, and ½ the chives. Toss to combine and set

1. ROAST THE AUBERGINE Preheat the oven to 220°C. Score the flesh side of the aubergine halves

- aside in the fridge. In a small bowl, combine the yoghurt with the remaining chives and season. 3. FRY THE MINCE Place a pan over medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, fry the mince and work quickly to break it up as it starts to cook. Fry until browned, 3-5 minutes (shifting occasionally).
- 4. CHERMOULA TIME Add the onion to the pan with the mince. Fry until soft, 3-4 minutes. Add the chermoula paste, the tomato paste, and the garlic. Fry until fragrant, 1-2 minutes. Mix in 100ml [200ml] of water. Bring to a boil and simmer until reduced and thickening, 6-8 minutes. Remove from the heat,
- 5. WHAT A FEAST! Plate the roasted aubergine flesh-side up. Top with the chermoula mince and dollop over the yoghurt. Side with the chickpea salad and sprinkle over the dates.
