Yum-Yum Beef Bowl

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Ingredients & Prep

75ml	Brown Basmati Rice
30ml	Lime Juice
15ml	Low Sodium Soy Sauce
15ml	Rice Wine Vinegar
100g	Shredded Cabbage & Julienne Carrot
1	Spring Onion sliced, keeping the white & green parts separate
50g	Edamame Beans

Black Sesame Seeds

Indonesian Soy Sauce

Coconut Yoghurt

150g Beef Schnitzel (without crumb)

1. LUSH RICE Rinse the rice and place in a pot over a medium-high heat. Submerge in 300ml of salted water and pop on a lid. Once boiling, reduce the heat and simmer for 25-30 minutes until most of the water has been absorbed. Keeping the lid on, remove from the heat and set aside

to steam for a further 10 minutes. On completion, drain if necessary and

- fluff up with a fork.

 2. FUSION SLAW Place lime juice (to taste), ½ the low sodium soy sauce, rice wine vinegar, and sweetener of choice in a jar or small bowl and shake or whisk to combine. Season to taste. Place the shredded red cabbage and julienne carrot, spring onion whites, and edamame beans in a large salad bowl. Drizzle over the soy-lime dressing (to taste) and toss to combine.
- 3. SEEDS & YUM YUM Place the sesame seeds in a nonstick pan over a medium heat. Toast for 2-4 minutes until they begin to pop, shifting regularly. Remove from the pan on completion. To make the yum yum sauce, combine the coconut yoghurt with the Indo soy sauce. Loosen with

water in 5ml increments until drizzling consistency. Season to taste.

- 4. JAPANESE SCHNITZEL Return the pan to a medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, pan-fry the schnitzel for 1-2 minutes per side until golden and cooked through. Deglaze the pan with the sesame oil and the remaining soy sauce. Remove the schnitzel from the pan, reserving the sauce, and season before slicing. Toss together the cooked rice and the shredded cabbage mixture and season to taste.
- **5. YUM YUM MEAL!** Plate up the brown rice and slaw mix and top with the sliced beef schnitzel/s. Drizzle with the yum yum sauce and the remaining pan juices. Sprinkle over the sesame seeds and spring onion greens. Yum-Yum!
