Ingredients & Prep Actions:

300g	400g	Penne Pasta
450g	600g	Pork Mince
2	2	Onions peel & finely dice 1½ [2]
60g	80g	Danish-style Feta drain
2	2	Garlic Cloves peel & grate
300g	400g	Cooked Chopped Tomato
45ml	60ml	NOMU Spice Blend (15ml [20ml] NOMU Italian Rub & 30ml [40ml] NOMU One For All Rub)
60g	80g	Green Leaves rinse

Oil (cooking, olive or coconut) Seasoning (salt & pepper)

Sugar/Sweetener/Honey

Water

- 1. AL DENTE PASTA Bring a pot of salted water to a boil for the pasta. Cook the pasta until al dente, 10-12 minutes. Drain and toss through a drizzle of olive oil.
- 2. MMMINCE In a bowl, combine the mince, ½ the onion (to taste), and seasoning. Wet your hands slightly and shape the mince mixture into 4-5 meatballs per portion. Stuff each meatball with a cube of feta. Set aside.
- 3. MAKE THE MEATBALLS Place a pan over medium heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, fry the meatballs until browned and cooked through, 8-10 minutes, shifting as they colour. Remove from the pan.
- 4. TASTY TOMATO SAUCE Place a pan over medium heat with a drizzle of oil. When hot, fry the remaining onion until soft, 4-5 minutes. Add the garlic and fry until fragrant, 1-2 minutes. Pour in the chopped tomatoes, the NOMU spice blend, 450ml [600ml] of water and a sweetener (to taste). Simmer until thickened, 12-15 minutes. Remove the pan from the heat and mix through the spinach.
- 5. LOOK AT THAT! Dish up the pasta, and top with the tomato sauce, and the stuffed meatballs. Crumble over any remaining feta.
