# Beef Schnitzel & Mint Yoghurt Wrap

with roasted beetroot, sautéed kale & a cucumber-radish salad

This delicious dinner would take first place in a wrap battle! Sizzling beef schnitzel strips are accompanied by a mix of tangy gherkins, minty yoghurt and a radish & cucumber salad. Featuring a coconut wrap and sided with roasted beetroot, it's the best on the block!

## Ingredients & Prep

- 400g Beetroot
  rinsed, trimmed, peeled
  (optional) & cut into
  bite-sized chunks
- 100g Cucumber cut into half-moons
- 40g Radish rinsed & thinly sliced into rounds
- 60ml Low Fat Plain Yoghurt
- 20g Gherkins drained & finely diced
- 8g Fresh Mint rinsed & finely chopped
- 100g Kale rinsed & roughly shredded
- 2 Gluten-free Coconut
- 300g Free-range Beef Schnitzel (without crumb)

Wraps

40g Salad Leaves

#### From Your Kitchen

Oil (cooking, olive or coconut)
Salt & Pepper

Butter Paper Towel **1. ROAST UP** Preheat the oven to 200°C. Place the beetroot chunks on a roasting tray, coat in oil, and season. Roast in the hot oven for 30-35 minutes until cooked through and crisping up, shifting halfway.

- 2. DREAMY DRESSING In a bowl, combine the cucumber half-moons, sliced radish, a drizzle of oil, and seasoning. In a separate small bowl, combine the yoghurt, diced gherkins, ½ the chopped mint, and seasoning.
- 3. KEEPIN IT KALE Place the shredded kale in a bowl with a drizzle of oil and some seasoning. Using your hands, gently massage until softened and well coated. Place a nonstick pan over medium heat. When hot, sauté
- **4.** WRAPPING IT UP Return the pan, wiped down, to a medium-high heat. When hot, dry toast the wraps one at a time for 30 seconds per side until warmed through. Remove from the pan and stack on a plate. Cover the wraps with a clean tea towel to keep warm.

5. SIZZLING SCHNITZEL When the roast has 10-15 minutes to go, return the pan to a high heat with a drizzle of oil. Pat the schnitzels dry

the kale for 2-3 minutes until wilted. Remove from the pan and return to

the bowl. Cover with a plate and set aside to keep warm until serving.

- with paper towel. When hot, fry the schnitzels for 30-60 seconds per side until golden and cooked through. In the final minute, add a knob of butter and baste the schnitzels. Remove from the pan, slice into thick strips, and season.

  6. WRAP UP THE NIGHT Time to assemble! Lay the wrap down, top
- 6. WRAP UP THE NIGHT Time to assemble! Lay the wrap down, top with the sautéed kale, rinsed salad leaves, beef strips and a dollop of the mint yoghurt dressing. Side with the beetroot and the radish-cucumber salad. \*Drops mic\*



If you have an air fryer, why not use it to cook the beetroot? Coat in oil, season, and pop in the air fryer at 200°C. Cook for 20-25 minutes or until cooked through and crispy.
